The Dental Hygiene Clinic is located on the DeLand Campus, Bert Fish Hall (Bldg. 6A), Rm. 100

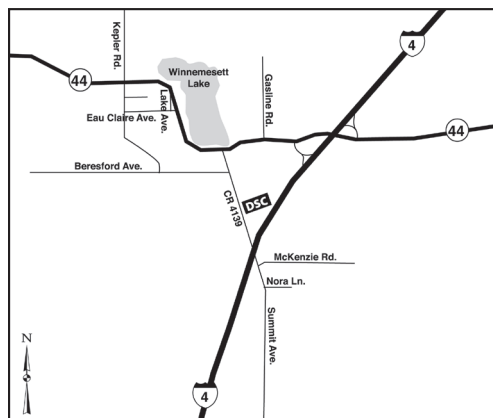

Come to the Dental Hygiene Clinic Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday between the hours of 10:30 a.m.-Noon or 2:30 p.m.-5 p.m. (office closes at 5 p.m.) to complete the necessary forms and PREPAY for a scheduled appointment. Cash and checks accepted; no credit cards.
