**COURSE**: This course will prepare instructor students to obtain FDLE certification as a High Liability Instructor in Defensive Tactics and instruct the CMS Criminal Justice Defensive Tactics Course in the Florida Basic Recruit Academy or agency in-service training. **Students must attend the entire course.** 

**ATTIRE**: BDU style long pants with belt loops, tennis shoes, multiple t-shirts, clean towel daily, socks, and hydrating beverages. A mouthpiece and groin protection are recommended. **Please note that shorts are** *NOT* **permitted**.

NOTE: Students are required to pass a written exam with a score of 85% or better and demonstrate the required proficiency skills at 100% pursuant to Rule 11B-35.0024. Students must participate in teaching a mini lesson of the course to their peers in the classroom.
