TOPICS TO BE COVERED INCLUDE: Aspects of Mental Illness, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), Crisis Theory and Intervention, Legal Aspects of Intervention, Assessment and Resolution, Substance Abuse, Child/Adolescent Issues, Crisis Negotiation Situations, Safety in Unique Situations, Elective Topics, and more.

NOTE: Students must attend all sessions of the course. Students are required to pass an end-of-course examination with a minimum of 80%.
