COURSE: This 16-hour hands on course provides students with the necessary training to perform the role of the breath test operator as it relates to obtaining and analyzing breath samples during the breath test and preparing the required documentation for court. Also, students will learn how to obtain and maintain a Breath Test Operator Permit according to the FDLE rule.

NOTE: Students must attend all sessions of the course. **Each student must successfully demonstrate proficiency in administering a breath test, complete the forms associated with the breath test, and pass a written exam with a score of 80% or better.**
