COURSE: This FDLE grant-funded course provides a hostage negotiator or team member with the basic skills needed to resolve a situation involving a hostage taker, barricaded subject, or suicidal individual. Tactical response, equipment, negotiation skills and mental health issues are all covered in class. Students must participate in curriculum role play scenarios.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED INCLUDE: Negotiations, Guidelines and Responsibilities, Behavioral Profiles, Personnel and Equipment Resources, Negotiations: Initial Response and Setup, Information Gathering, Strategy and Technique, Stress Management, and more.

NOTE: Students must attend all sessions of the course and participate in curriculum role play. Students are required to pass an end-of-course examination with a minimum of 80%.
