Hello. Thank you for your interest in the programs and services offered at the Center for Women and Men. This is a brief overview, but I hope you will come in and visit us for more information.

We have a childcare assistance program called CCAMPIS: Childcare Access means Parents in School. At CCAMPS, we can help moms and dads pay for a portion of childcare costs, so that parents can focus on their studies.

We have a New Directions program, which can help pay for tuition, books, uniforms, and equipment for eligible students enrolled in vocational programs.

We have a Fresh Start program for those in the community who wish to come to Daytona State, but aren't sure where to begin. They can join our free four-week workshop and gain life skills, employability tools, computer and financial literacy, and confidence in themselves, as well as in the process for enrolling in a program here at the college.

We serve our homeless students with a food pantry, clothing closet, school supplies, free printing, access to health care, a staff or faculty mentor, and many community resources. And our center has a lending library for students to borrow a book for the semester. This is a limited supply, and first come first served, so please come early.

In addition, we have a clothing closet to help any Daytona State Student get career ready, free Falcon Fuel snacks for students on the go, and emergency bus passes if you have a transportation crisis. Plus, access to low or no cost healthcare for you and your family.
