<p>Scene 2: ASC & Writing Center</p> <p>Our nationally recognized Academic Support Center provides tutoring and other services that can help you make the grade. Highly qualified learning specialists, professional and peer tutors, and faculty are available to help you succeed. You can get assistance in-person at any of the six ASC locations as well as virtually via the ASC's live chat. Best of all, services provided by the Academic Support Center are free, so take advantage of this great resource, and remember, if things get tough, the ASC has your back. The DSC Writing Center, recognized nationally as a Center of Excellence, is here to help you with all your communication needs. Here, you can get personalized assistance, whether it's for a course, a personal project, resume, test prep or scholarship essay. We offer both virtual and in-person appointments where you can sit down with a tutor to discuss your needs for up to 45 minutes. We also have a chat if you just have a quick question that you need answered. You should contact a CAS Counselor before enrolling in classes each semester, to ensure you get the assistance you need to succeed.</p> <p>CAS Counselors can also provide short term counseling to help you cope with the many demands of being a college student. They can also link students to local community mental health professionals for long term counseling, treatment, or therapeutic intervention.
