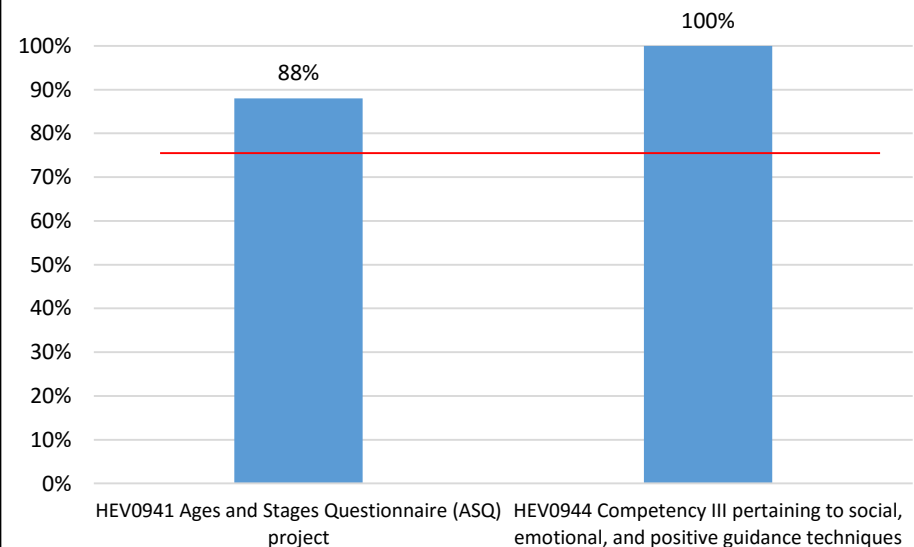

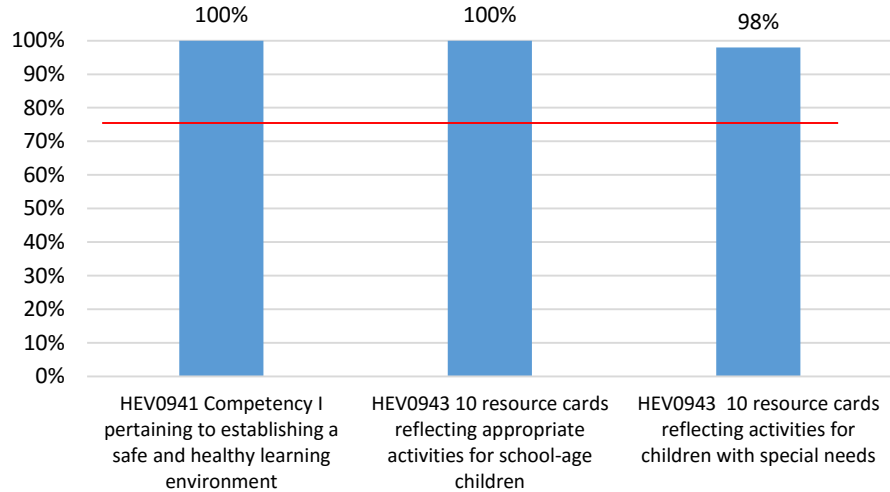

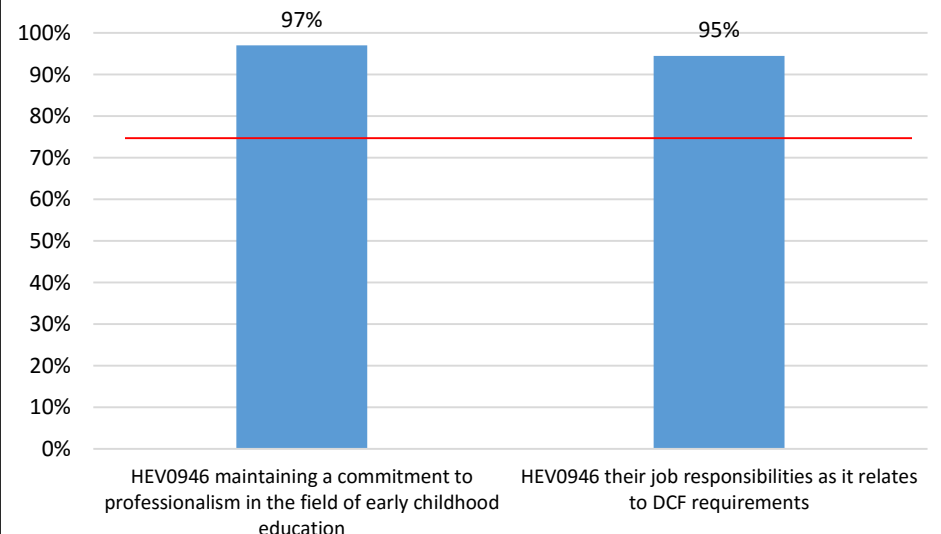
Assessment Results 2016-2017

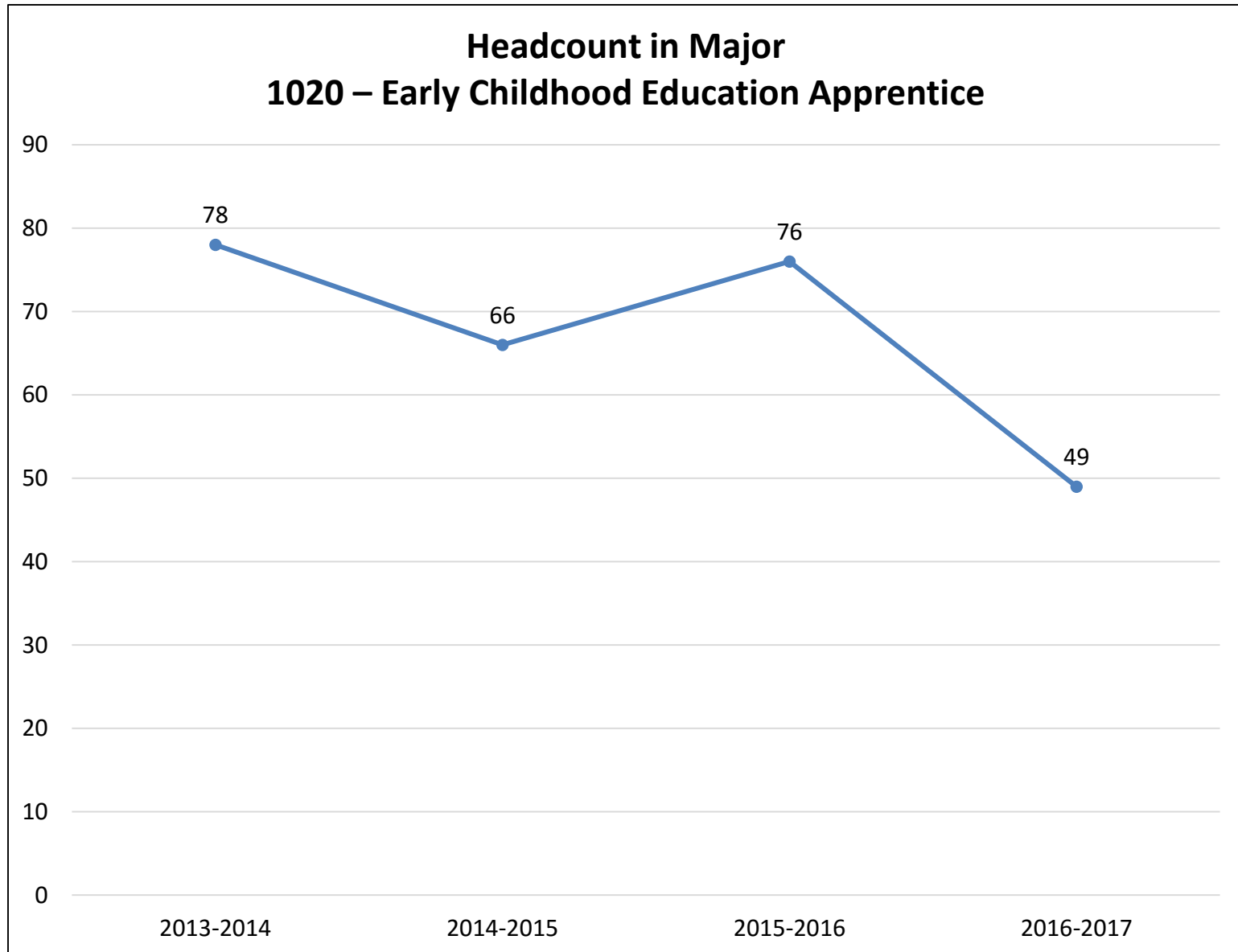

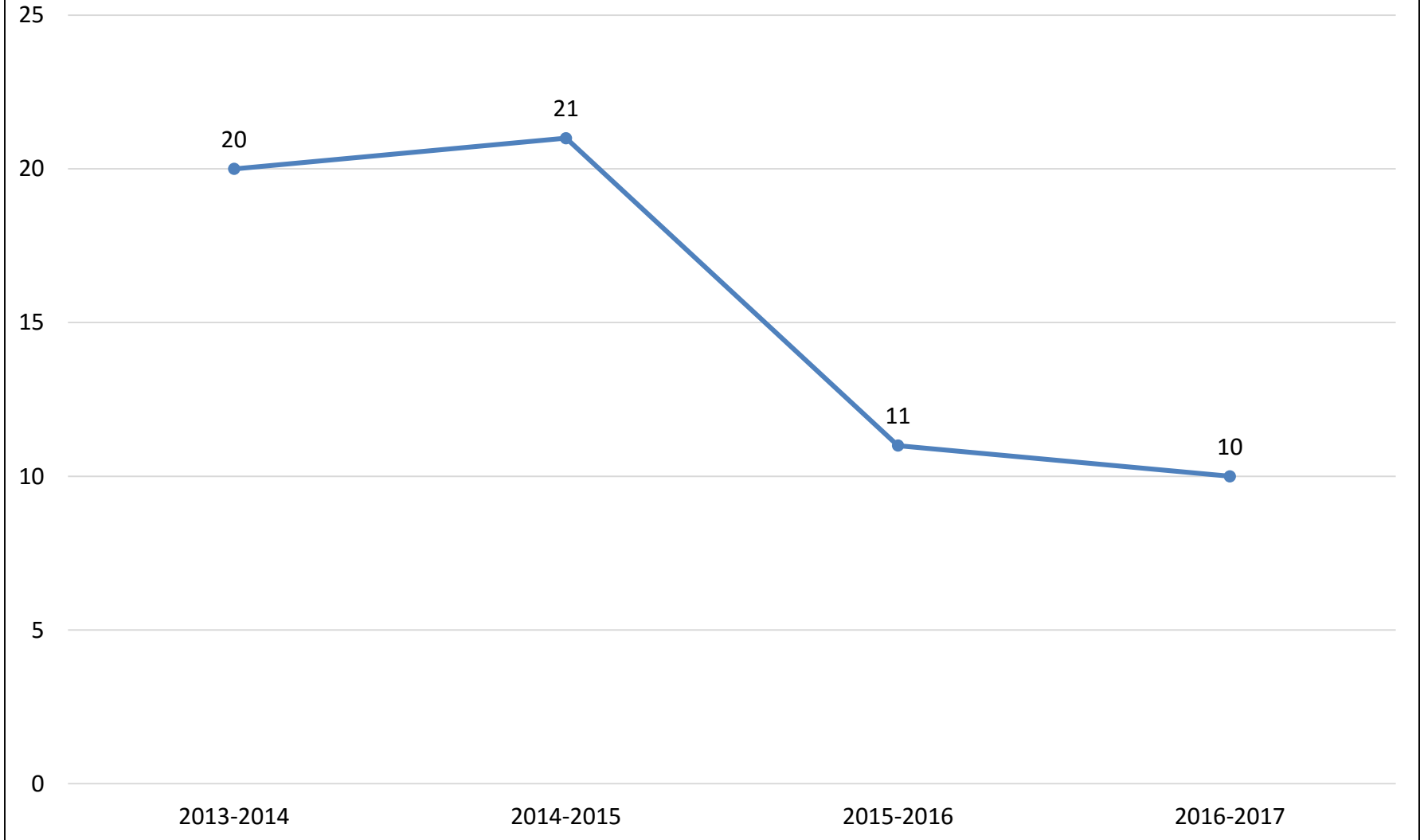

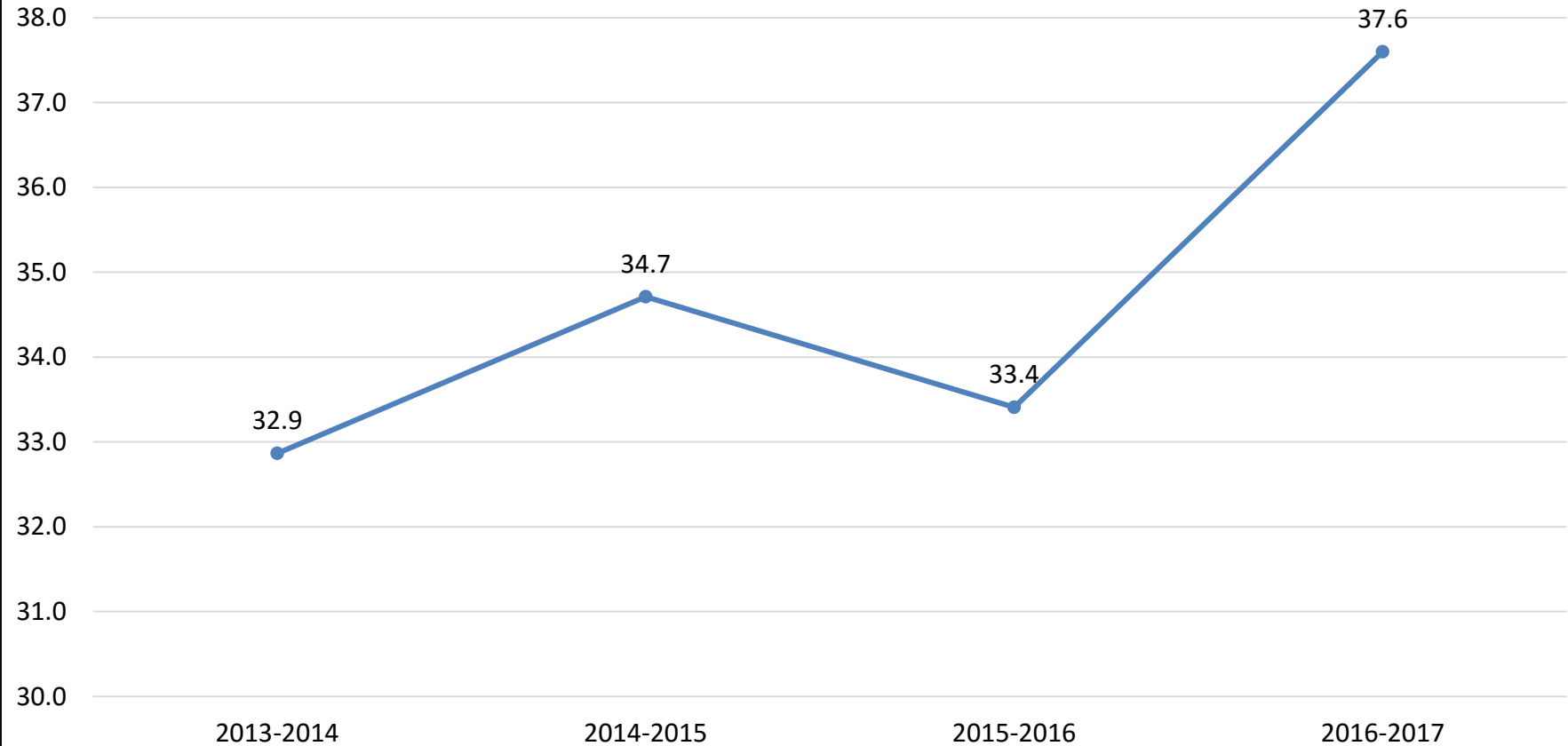

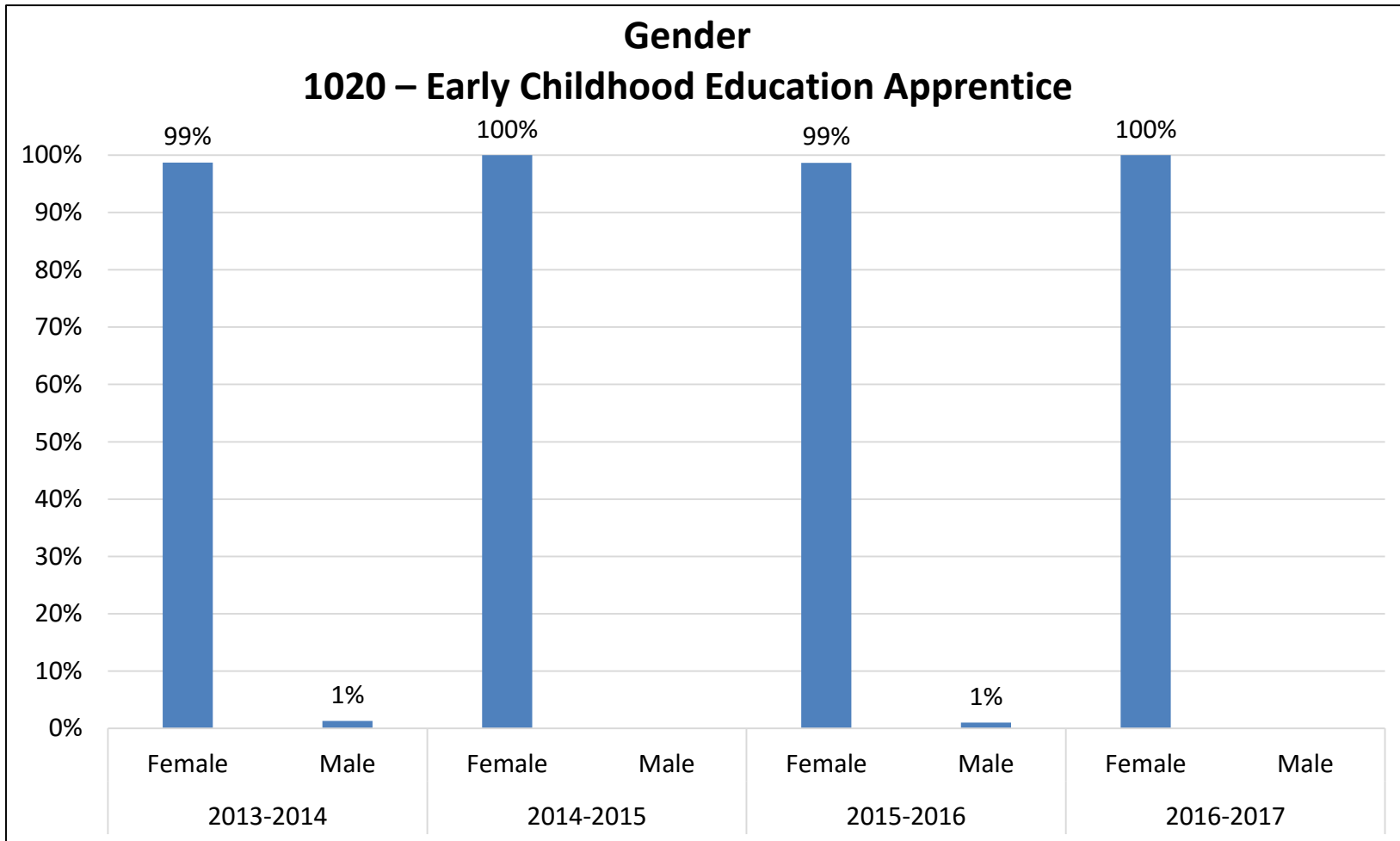
Number of Graduates 1020 – Early Childhood Education Apprentice
