Student Acknowledgement – Waiver and Release of Liability

As a student of Daytona State College, I understand the requirements to participate in clubs and student activities on campus. By participating in these voluntary activities, I agree to abide by the following requirements:

I will notify the VP for Student Development, via e-mail, at CovidHealth@DaytonaState.edu of any exposure to COVID-19 prior to returning to campus.

I am at least 18 years of age. I have read and understand the terms of this Waiver and Release of Liability. For Students under the age of 18: I am the parent or legal guardian of a student who is under the age of 18. I agree on behalf of my child or ward to all the terms and conditions contained in this Waiver and Release of Liability.

In consideration of participation in any Student Life Clubs and/or Programs, including but not limited to, meetings, practices, training, participation in activities, travel, transportation, and lodging, I agree to assume the risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury, illness, disability, death, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense of any kind, that I may experience or incur in connection with my participation in DSC Student Life programs. I release and covenant not to sue DSC, the District Board of Trustees, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and representatives from any liability related to my participation in DSC Student Life Programs, including liability related to exposure or infection related to COVID-19.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless DSC, the District Board of Trustees, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and representatives, from any and all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs, or losses of any kind (including attorney fees and costs through appeal) arising from or out of or related to exposure or infection by COVID-19 or any other illness or injury, including death related in any way to my participation in a DSC Student Life program.

I further fully agree that the above acknowledgment of Waiver and Release of Liability is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Florida and that if any portion is held invalid, it is agreed that the remaining will continue in full legal force and effect.

Each of the following requirements is based on current CDC recommendations. Requirements may be adjusted as additional CDC recommendations are released:

- Face coverings are optional for all outdoor activities and while in any building on campus. I understand that if I have not been fully vaccinated, the CDC continues to recommend face coverings at most outdoor gatherings and when indoors (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019->

[ncov/vaccines/pdfs/choosingSaferAct.pdf](https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/pdfs/choosingSaferAct.pdf)). It is recommended that face coverings be made with at least 2 layers of breathable material and fully cover the nose and mouth. Single-layer coverings, open-chin triangle bandanas and masks with holes or vents of any kind are not appropriate face coverings. (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/fully-vaccinated-guidance.html>).

- I will practice social distancing techniques and stay at least 3 feet apart from other people.
- I will practice regular handwashing. The College has hand sanitizers available in buildings and classrooms.
- If I use equipment, tools, or materials, I will follow proper sanitizing protocols and sanitize them between users.
- If I have fever, cough or flu-like symptoms, I will follow CDC guidelines, immediately remove myself from class, notify my instructor, and only return to campus when:
 - At least 10 days have passed since my symptoms first appeared
AND
 - I have had no fever (100.4°F or greater) for at least 24 hours (that is one full day of no fever without the use of medicine that reduces fevers)
AND
 - Other symptoms have improved (for example, cough or shortness of breath have improved)
AND
 - I have been contacted and cleared to return to campus by Student Development
- If I have a confirmed case of COVID-19, I will follow CDC guidelines, immediately remove myself from class, notify my instructor, and only return to campus when:
 - At least 10 days have passed since my positive test
AND
 - I have had no fever (100.4°F or greater) for at least 24 hours (that is one full day of no fever without the use of medicine that reduces fevers)
AND
 - Other symptoms have improved (for example, cough or shortness of breath have improved)
AND
 - I have been contacted and cleared to return to campus by Student Development
- If I have come in close contact with anyone who has a confirmed case of COVID-19 I will follow CDC guidelines, immediately remove myself from class, and notify my instructor. A close contact as defined by the CDC is any individual who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes (cumulative over a 24-hour period), provided care at home to someone who was sick with COVID-19, had direct physical contact (hugged or kissed) someone with COVID-19, shared eating or drinking utensils, or was sneezed on, coughed on, or got respiratory droplets on them from someone with COVID-19 (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/quarantine.html>), “irrespective of whether the person with COVID-19 or the contact was wearing a mask” (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/php/public-health-recommendations.html>), starting from 2 days prior to illness onset or a positive test. Per CDC guidelines, the following options are utilized for ending quarantine after close contact (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/more/scientific-brief-options-to-reduce-quarantine.html>):
 - Quarantine can end after Day 10 without testing and if no symptoms have occurred or were reported without the use of pharmaceutical interventions during daily monitoring.
OR

- Quarantine can end after Day 7 if a diagnostic test (PCR or Rapid Antigen Test) is taken and is negative and if no symptoms occurred or were reported without the use of pharmaceutical interventions during daily monitoring. The test must be taken within 48 hours before the planned end of quarantine (Day 6 from exposure), but quarantine cannot be discontinued earlier than after Day 7.
- In either case, I will not return to campus until I have been contacted and cleared to return to campus by Student Development
- If I am fully vaccinated (it has been 2 weeks since my final vaccination dose) and I have been exposed to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, I do not need to quarantine. I will however still monitor my symptoms for 14 days and report any symptoms that occur (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/fully-vaccinated-guidance.html>).
- I will notify the VP for Student Development, via e-mail, at CovidHealth@DaytonaState.edu prior to returning to campus
- If I have a lab confirmed, positive test for COVID-19, my close contact classmates may be contacted and informed, though my personal information will not be shared.
- The College will provide accommodations, to the extent possible, to make up work missed due to illness.
- I understand that if I am registered for a hybrid or face to face section, this class could switch to an online format if necessary.
- I understand that the College is providing the safest environment possible and acknowledge that all risks cannot be eliminated.

I understand that if I fail to comply with any of the above requirements that I may be removed from the classroom, lab or the College and may not have another opportunity to finish the course this semester.
