The program is broken into seven levels, starting with water adjustment skills and advances to competitive stroke perfection. Water safety is stressed and taught to all students.

Instructors are all certified American Red Cross Water Safety Instructors.

REGISTRATION DETAILS

REGISTER NOW! PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED.

Classes are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. It is recommended that registration be done inperson at the Daytona State College Aquatics Center, located in building 310 on the Daytona Beach Campus at 1200 W. International Speedway Blvd.

Payment is required at registration. Cash, checks and credit cards are accepted. Driver's license numbers are required on all checks.

Withdrawal for full refund must be made no less than three business days prior to the first day of lessons. A \$10.00 refund fee will be charged. No refunds or transfers will be given on or after the first day the lesson begins. Swim lessons require a specific instructor/student ratio.

Please note that water temperatures may vary.
