PLAN A:

Usual distribution of F2F – Hybrid – Online classes.

Masks optional in classes and laboratories.

Safe Classroom Capacity of 3' distance between seats

HyFlex as an option in F2F classes so that “normal” enrollment numbers can be reached (half students attend one day, the other half live online).

PLAN B:

Usual distribution of F2F – Hybrid – Online classes, with exception of larger classes which move to HyFlex to reduce capacity

Masks optional in classes and laboratories.

Safe Classroom Capacity of 3' distance between seats

HyFlex as an option in F2F classes so that “normal” enrollment numbers can be reached (half students attend one day, the other half live online).

Gen ed lecture/AE	Normal distribution of F2F, Hybrid and Online. HyFlex used to increase enrollment to normal levels for any class over 40. Hybrids taught in rooms using SCC number at 3' as enrollment cap.	
Gen ed labs (science, EVR, MPT, PGY)	Some labs are online, some F2F depending on room capacity.	
Performance classes – Music, art, theatre	F2F with proper social distancing in rooms using SCC of 6' for enrollment cap	Use of more distance, masks and instrument covers for singing and instrumental classes
Ensemble classes – band, orchestra, live plays	F2F with proper social distancing in rooms using SCC of 6' for enrollment cap. Limit size, move outside or eliminate large ensembles.	Use of more distance, masks and instrument covers for singing and instrumental classes
Health Sciences and EMS	Both F2F and Hybrid, with skills labs taught F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.	
PSAV	F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap. No sharing of tools and students paired in small groups using masks.	Continue with clinicals but possibly close massage therapy clinic to the public; dental clinic to remain open.
Cosmetology and Barbering	F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.	Possibly close salon to public
Culinary	Hybrid and F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap	30-79% online, may vary by class
Con Ed: Health Institute, etc	F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.	
Con Ed: CBI	F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.	
Café 101	Open to public with limited seating with SCC in mind.	

PLAN C:

Move % TBD of lecture F2F to HyFlex or Hybrid (or online) to reduce density on campus. Existing Hybrids remain in place. Keep set of gateway F2F courses fully F2F in classrooms with larger distance between seats (6')

Reconfigure vocational classes to reduce density.

Masks optional in classes and laboratories.

CLASS TYPE	MODALITY	COMMENTS
Gen ed lecture/AE	Keep FTIC Lecture courses as F2F in classrooms with larger capacity (6'). Move remaining lecture courses to HyFlex or Hybrid.	
Gen ed labs (science, EVR, MPT, PGY)	Most labs move to online, some F2F depending on room capacity.	Prioritize labs with FTIC enrollment to remain F2F
Performance classes – Music, art, theatre	F2F with proper social distancing but moved outdoors (Landing, etc.)	Use of more distance, masks and instrument covers for singing and instrumental classes
Ensemble classes – band, orchestra, live plays	F2F with proper social distancing in rooms using SCC of 6' for enrollment cap. Eliminate large ensembles.	Use of more distance, masks and instrument covers for singing and instrumental classes
Health Sciences and EMS	Both F2F and Hybrid, with skills labs taught F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.	
PSAV	F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.	Close massage therapy clinic to the public; dental clinic to remain open.
Cosmetology and Barbering	Convert classes to hybrid, with F2F portion in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.	Close salon to public
Culinary	Hybrid and F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap	30-79% online, may vary by class
Con Ed: Health Institute, etc	Convert classes to online where possible; F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.	
Con Ed: CBI	Convert classes to online where possible; F2F in rooms using SCC number as enrollment cap.

PLAN D:

Move all or most lecture F2F, HyFlex and Hybrid to online. Possibly teach FTIC in large auditoriums with PPE.

Masks optional in classes and laboratories.

Safe Classroom Capacity of 6' distance between seats for vocational classes. No sharing equipment or tools.

Gen ed lecture/AE	Move all or most lecture classes to online, either synchronous or asynchronous.	May still offer some FTIC Gateway courses has F2F in large rooms and/or Hybrid.
Gen ed labs (science, EVR, MPT, PGY)	Labs move to online, either synchronous or asynchronous.	
Performance classes – Music, art, theatre	Move to online or synchronous virtual teaching	
Ensemble classes – band, orchestra, live plays	Move to synchronous virtual teaching where possible, or online instruction	
Health Sciences and EMS	Possibly convert to online with skills labs postponed	
PSAV	Possibly convert to online with skills labs postponed	Proportions that can be taught online differ by program
