

DAYTONA STATE COLLEGE - TEAS Exam Information Sheet

for DENTAL HYGIENE, LPN, RN, RADIOGRAPHY, and SONOGRAPHY

The TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is required for application to Dental Hygiene, Licensed Practical Nursing (LPN), Associate Degree in Nursing (RN-ADN), Transition to Professional Nursing, Radiography, and Sonography programs at Daytona State College.

Starting July 1, 2025, only TEAS test taken at Daytona State College will be accepted.

PREPARATION

The TEAS on-line practice assessment and study guide are available from Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI) at [atitesting.com](https://www.atitesting.com). Information about the test format as well as how to prepare for the test is available on the web site. In addition, the Daytona State College Academic Support Center (ASC) can be utilized for tutoring and study materials.

Please plan to start your test a minimum of 4 to 4.5 hours before the Assessment office closes. See the Assessment Services website for hours of each campus. INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 1:** Prior to the exam, students **must** create an account online with ATI at [atitesting.com](https://www.atitesting.com). See instructions on the back of this handout. This log in information will be required to take the TEAS test with Assessment Services at Daytona State College.
- Step 2:** Prepare to spend 4-4.5 hours from beginning to end for payment, registration, and testing. A valid physical government issued photo ID with and a debit or credit card is **required** to take the TEAS.
- Step 3:** Pay the \$15 DSC Proctor Fee (\$30 for non-DSC students). Testers will obtain a payment slip from the Assessment office to pay the proctor fee to Student Accounts.
- Step 4:** Assessment Services will place the student in a testing room where they will use their ATI log-in information from Step 1 to pay for their TEAS Exam through ATI online. Once this is complete and verified, the student will then begin the test. The test is timed and can take 4 hours to complete. Questions will cover topics of Mathematics, Reading, Science, and English/Language Usage. Calculators are built into the test when allowed. **Handheld calculators are NOT allowed when taking the TEAS test.**

For the ATI TEAS, the following criteria must be met for **ALL PROGRAMS**:

Adjusted Individual Total Score (AITS) 65th percentile or better

- **Starting July 1, 2025, only TEAS test taken at Daytona State College will be accepted.** If you took the TEAS prior to July 1, 2025 with another Florida Public College/University or online through ATI directly, your scores can still be used for consideration to one of the programs as long as they are still valid (3 years).
- Examinees may test a total of four (4) times within a calendar year (Jan-Dec).
- Retesting can be administered after a 30-day wait (on the 31st day). Students who wish to retest on the TEAS must pay the current DSC and ATI test fees each time.
- Scores are good for 3 years.

If you do not receive a passing score, it is recommended that you utilize the **Academic Support Center (ASC)** for tutoring (see ASC website for further information).

How to Create an Account with ATI for TEAS Exam

Go to atitesting.com and click on “**CREATE ACCOUNT**”



STEP 1 – Enter your name, a username, email address and mobile number. **Type Daytona State College and select one of the following –**

Select “**Daytona State College ADN**” if you are a **RN/ADN/Transition** student.

Select “**Daytona State College PN**” if you are a **Practical Nursing (PN/LPN)** student.

Select “**Daytona State College TEAS**” if you are a **Radiography, Sonography, or Dental Hygiene** student.

Create a password and confirm the password.

Enter your Billing Address information and click **CREATE AN ACCOUNT**.

STEP 2 – Enter your **STUDENT ID number**, make sure you enter your Daytona State College student id number. If you are not a Daytona State College student, please enter the id number for your home institution. Check the Non-Degree Seeking box and click Continue.

STEP 3 – Enter your BIRTHDATE and click Complete.

Congratulations you have completed creating your Username and Password for ATI. Don’t forget to have your Username and Password information ready when you come to Assessment Services to take the TEAS Exam. Testers will **NOT** pay or register for the test through ATI's website when creating their ATI account, once you have created your account **STOP**. TEAS exam will be purchased once you sit for your exam at the Daytona State College Assessment Services testing room.
