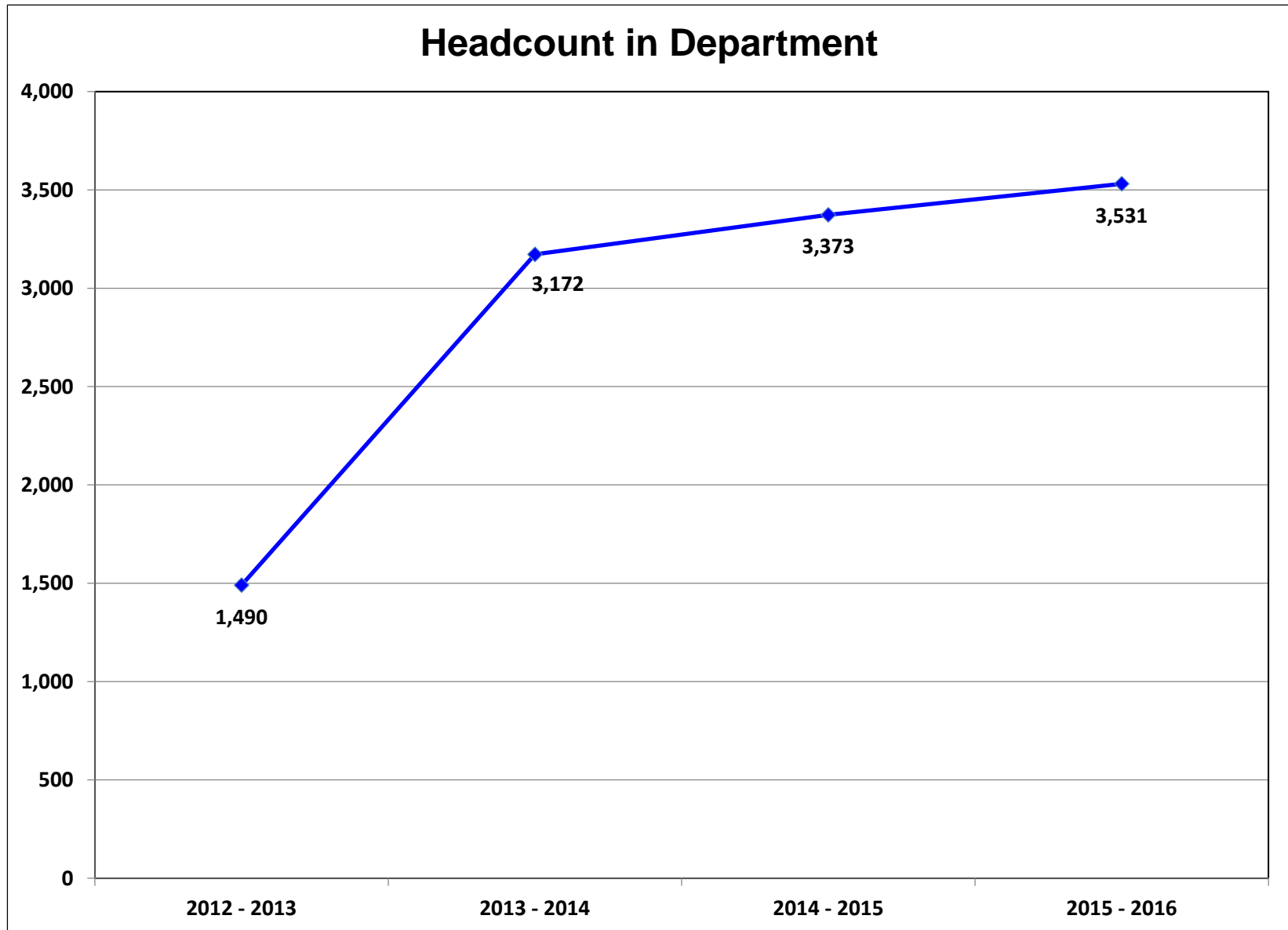

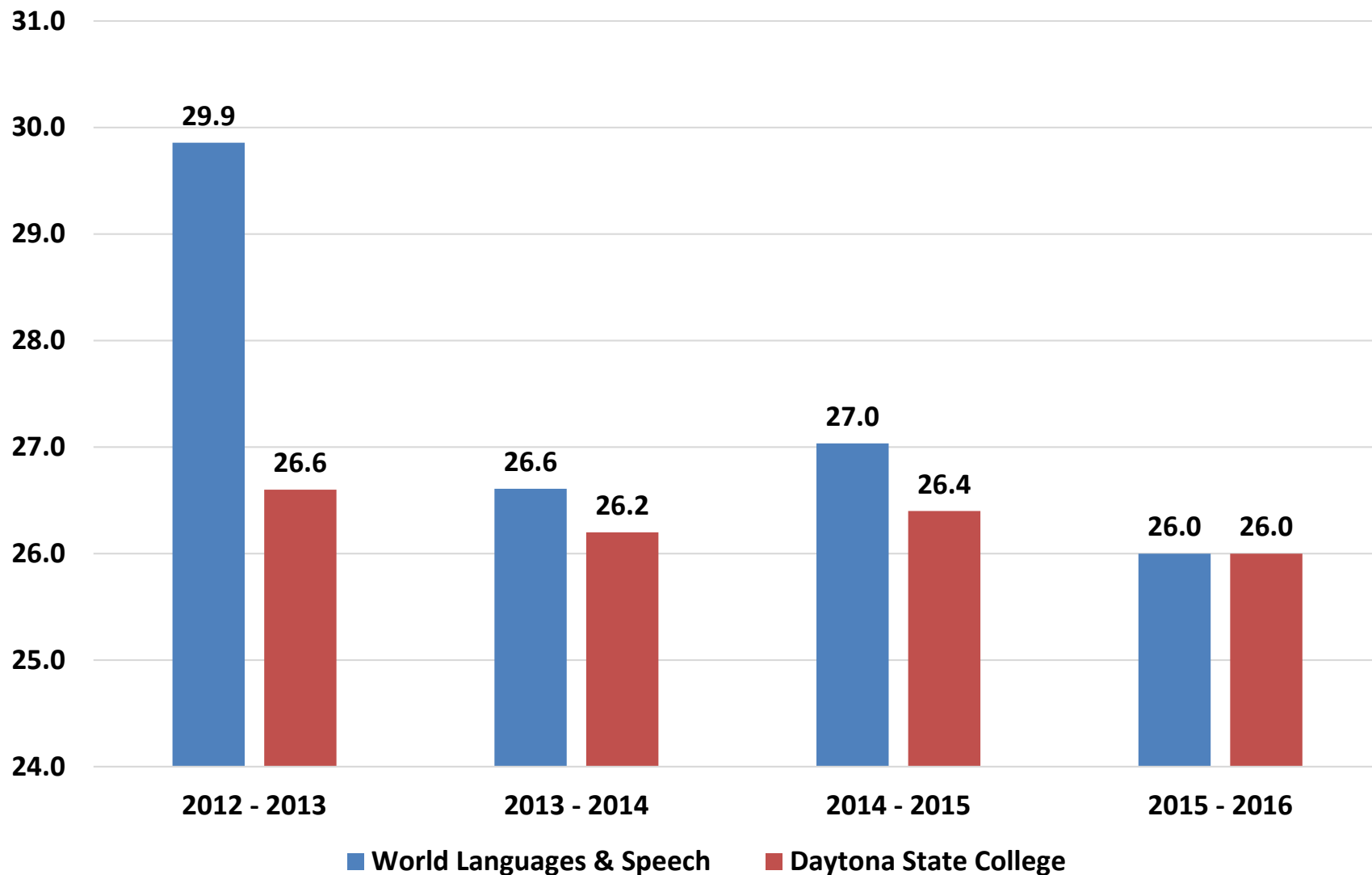

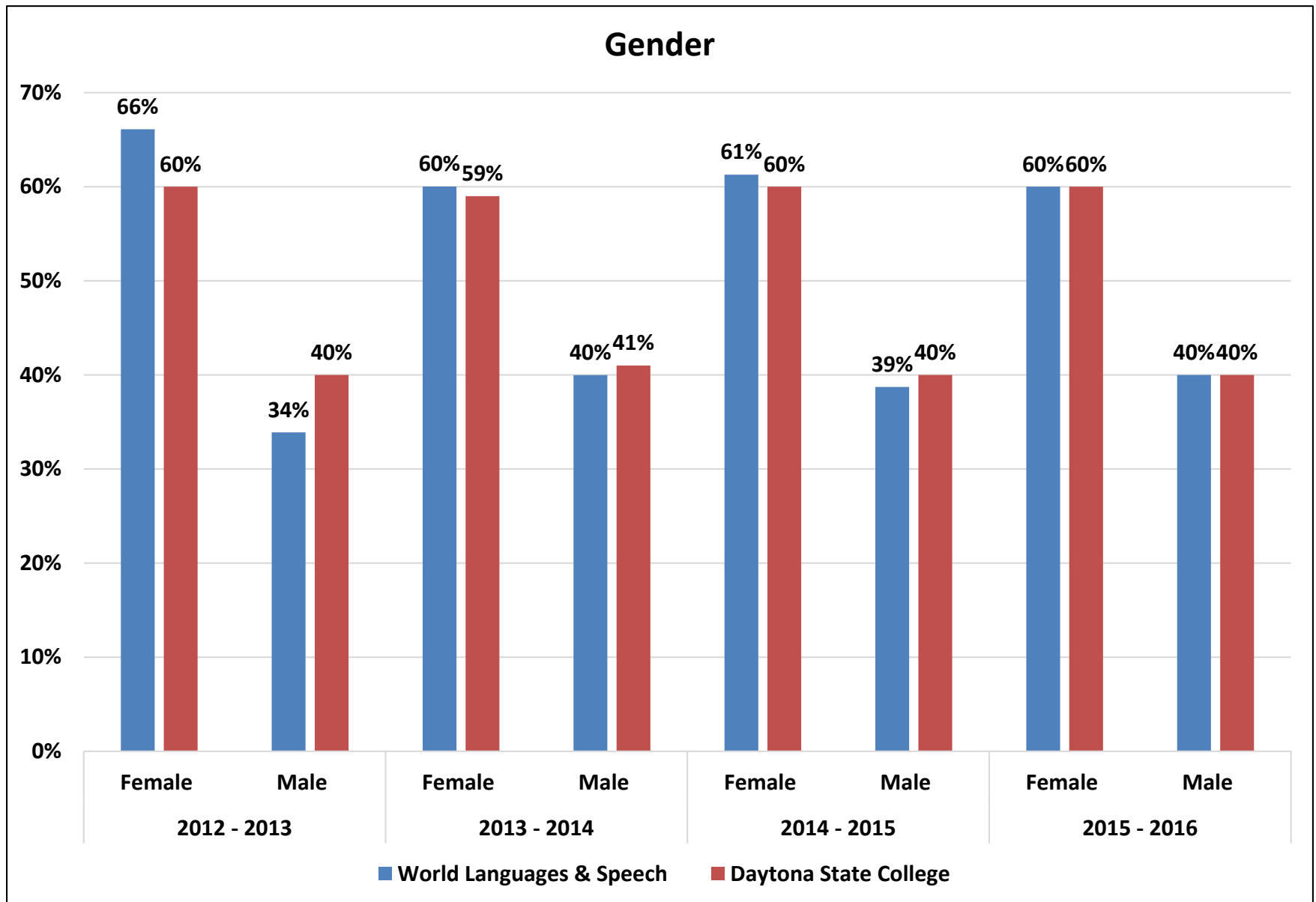

Average Age in Department

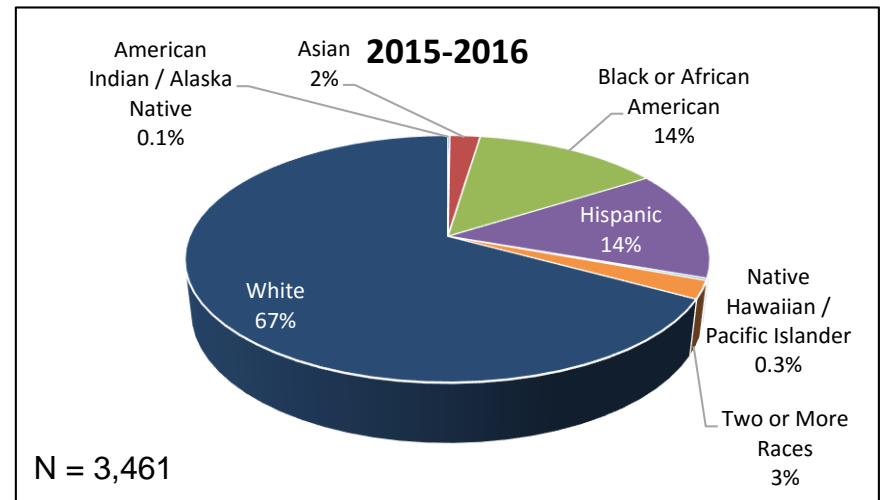
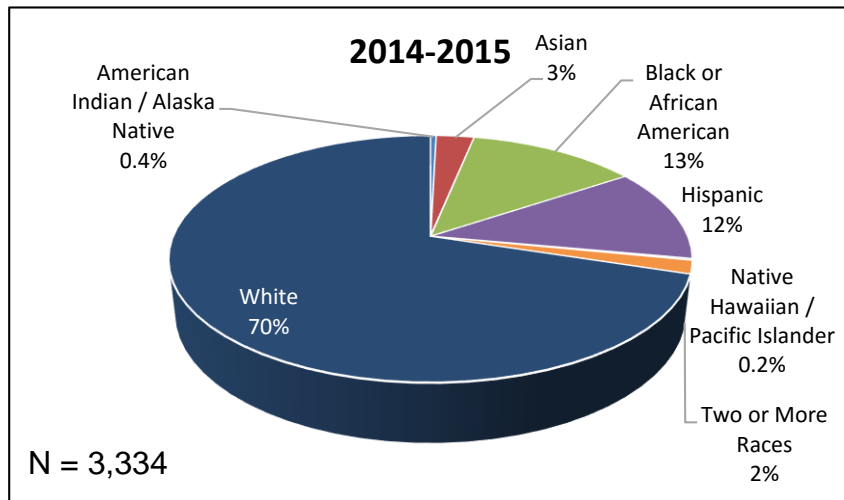
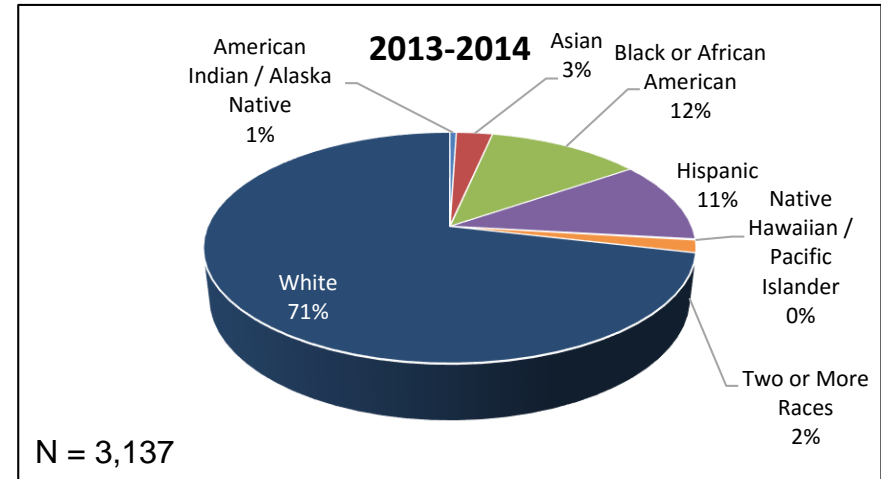
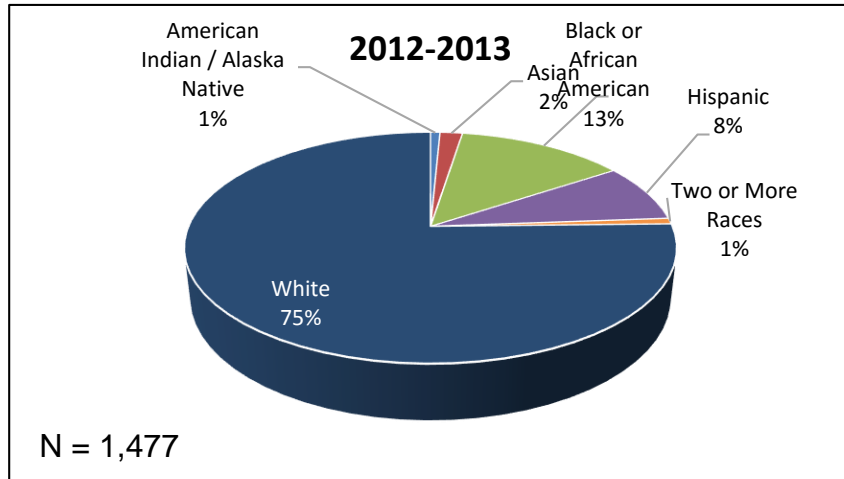
